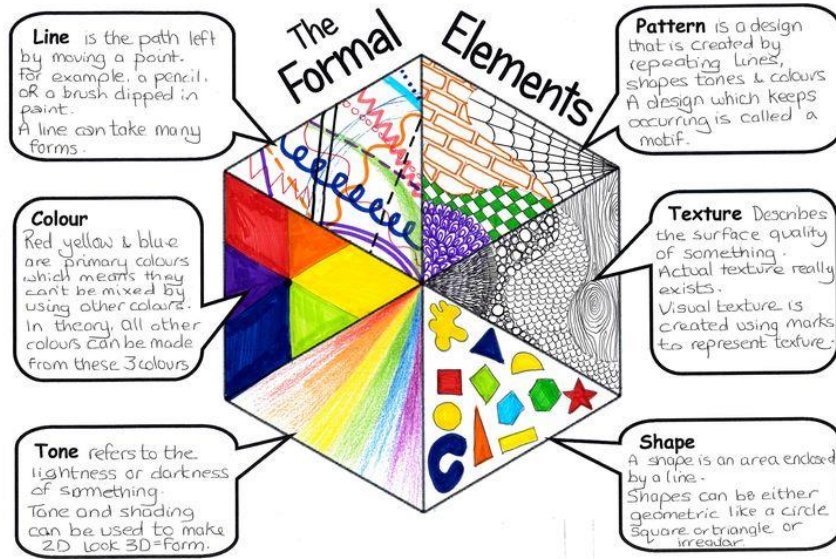


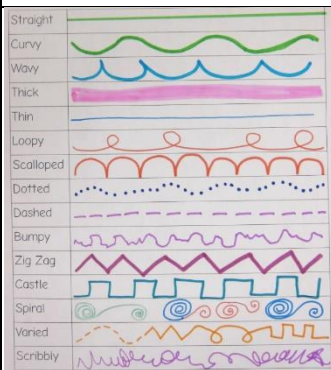

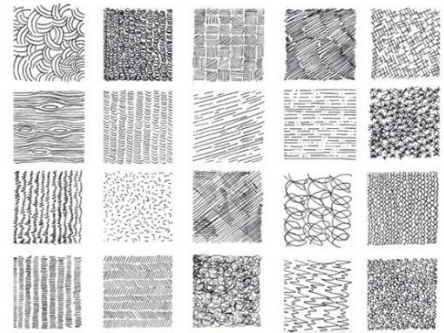
Skills lessons - Drawing



Key Vocabulary



- Line types** (spiky/wavy, neat/messy, blurry/sharp, muddy/clear, smooth/rough, fluffy/coarse)
- Line thickness** (thick/thin, fine/dense)
- Materials/tools** (charcoal, chalk, pencils, oil pastels, graphite, drawing ink, soft pastels)
- Tone** (matt/shiny, light/dark, soft/hard)
- Mark making** (stippling, cross-hatching, dashes, spirals)
